For The Second Service

We thank two gentlemen for sharing their music with us—Jeremy Irland and Michael LeFevre. Michael LeFevre began studying guitar at age 15 in Ohio and graduated from Cornish College of the Arts in 1992. Within three years he had received top prizes at national competitions such as the Northwest Guitar Festival and the Portland Guitar Festival, as well as at the International Guitar Congress Competition in Corfu, Greece. In 2008 he performed in Benaroya Hall as part of the Seattle Symphony's subscription series. He has also performed with the Seattle Opera, the Seattle Guitar Trio, and the St. Helen's String Quartet. From 2007-2009 he led the classical guitar program at Cornish College of the Arts. Please join me in wishing Michael an especially warm Walla Walla welcome for only a few weeks ago he moved here with his wife Yuki, a new faculty member at Whitman College.

Michael's prelude consists of *The Cathedral*, a three-movement work by Agustín Barrios (1885-1944) and the second *Pavan* by Luis Milan (1502-1561). The introit and offertory, both by Johann Sebastian Bach (1685-1750) derive from *Cello Suite No. 1* (BWV1007) and *Cantata BWV140*, respectively.

As promised about a month ago we get to hear our own Jeremy Irland sing one more time this summer. The anthem presents the third of *Five Mystical Songs* by Ralph Vaughan Williams (1872-1958), with words by the 17th-century Welsh poet and preacher George Herbert (1593-1633). As you prepare to worship, please take some quiet time to meditate on these profound words.

*Love bade me welcome; yet my soul drew back,  
Guilty of dust and sin.  
But quick-eyed Love, observing me grow slack  
From my first entrance in,  
Drew nearer to me, sweetly questioning,  
If I lack'd anything.*

*"A guest," I answered, "worthy to be here."  
Love said, "You shall be he."  
"I, the unkind, ungrateful? Ah, my dear,  
I cannot look on thee."  
Love took my hand and smiling did reply,
